SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4982

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled
"The state school aid act of 1979,"

(MCL 388.1601 to 388.1896) by adding section 31b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 31B. (1) FROM THE APPROPRIATIONS IN SECTION 11, THERE IS
- 2 ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000.00 FOR 2013-2014 FOR
- 3 GRANTS TO AT-RISK DISTRICTS FOR IMPLEMENTING A YEAR-ROUND
- 4 INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM.
- 5 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SELECT DISTRICTS FOR GRANTS UNDER
- 6 THIS SECTION FROM AMONG APPLICANT DISTRICTS THAT MEET BOTH OF THE
- 7 FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) THE DISTRICT IS ELIGIBLE IN 2013-2014 FOR THE COMMUNITY
- 9 ELIGIBILITY OPTION FOR FREE AND REDUCED PRICE LUNCH UNDER 42 USC
- 10 1759A.
- 11 (B) THE BOARD OF THE DISTRICT HAS ADOPTED A RESOLUTION STATING

- 1 THAT THE DISTRICT WILL IMPLEMENT A YEAR-ROUND INSTRUCTIONAL
- 2 CALENDAR FOR 2014-2015 FOR AT LEAST 1 SCHOOL OPERATED BY THE
- 3 DISTRICT AND COMMITTING TO PROVIDING THE YEAR-ROUND INSTRUCTIONAL
- 4 CALENDAR IN EACH OF THOSE SCHOOLS FOR AT LEAST 3 SCHOOL YEARS.
- 5 (3) A DISTRICT SEEKING A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY
- 6 TO THE DEPARTMENT IN THE FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT NOT LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2014. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 8 SELECT DISTRICTS FOR GRANTS AND MAKE NOTIFICATION NOT LATER THAN
- 9 MAY 1, 2014.
- 10 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL AWARD GRANTS UNDER THIS SECTION ON A
- 11 FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS, BUT SHALL GIVE PRIORITY BASED
- 12 SOLELY ON CONSIDERATION OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
- 13 (A) GIVING PRIORITY TO DISTRICTS WITH LOWER GENERAL FUND
- 14 BALANCES AS A PERCENT OF REVENUES.
- 15 (B) GIVING PRIORITY TO DISTRICTS THAT OPERATE AT LEAST 1
- 16 SCHOOL THAT HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS EITHER A
- 17 PRIORITY SCHOOL OR A FOCUS SCHOOL.
- 18 (C) ENSURING THAT GRANT FUNDING INCLUDES BOTH RURAL AND URBAN
- 19 DISTRICTS.
- 20 (5) THE AMOUNT OF A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION TO ANY 1 DISTRICT
- 21 SHALL NOT EXCEED \$750,000.00.
- 22 (6) A GRANT PAYMENT UNDER THIS SECTION TO A DISTRICT SHALL BE
- 23 USED FOR NECESSARY MODIFICATIONS TO INSTRUCTIONAL FACILITIES,
- 24 MODIFICATIONS TO CURRENT CONTRACTS, AND OTHER NONRECURRING COSTS OF
- 25 PREPARING FOR THE OPERATION OF A YEAR-ROUND INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM
- 26 AS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 27 (7) A DISTRICT RECEIVING A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT

- 1 REQUIRED TO PROVIDE MORE THAN THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF DAYS AND HOURS
- 2 OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION PRESCRIBED UNDER SECTION 101, BUT SHALL SPREAD
- 3 AT LEAST THOSE MINIMUM AMOUNTS OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION OVER THE ENTIRE
- YEAR IN EACH OF ITS SCHOOLS IN WHICH A YEAR-ROUND INSTRUCTIONAL 4
- CALENDAR IS IMPLEMENTED. THE DISTRICT SHALL COMMIT TO PROVIDING THE 5
- 6 YEAR-ROUND INSTRUCTIONAL CALENDAR IN EACH OF THOSE SCHOOLS FOR AT
- LEAST 3 SCHOOL YEARS. 7
- 8 (8) FOR A DISTRICT RECEIVING A GRANT UNDER THIS SECTION,
- 9 EXCESSIVE HEAT IS CONSIDERED TO BE A CONDITION NOT WITHIN THE
- 10 CONTROL OF SCHOOL AUTHORITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DAYS OR HOURS
- 11 BEING COUNTED AS DAYS OR HOURS OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION UNDER SECTION
- 12 101(4).
- (9) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 17B, GRANT PAYMENTS TO DISTRICTS 13
- 14 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID ON A SCHEDULE DETERMINED BY THE
- 15 DEPARTMENT.
