## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4677

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act,"

by amending section 25 (MCL 205.75), as amended by 2012 PA 226.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 25. (1) All money received and collected under this act
- 2 shall be deposited by the department in the state treasury to the
- 3 credit of the general fund, except as otherwise provided in this
- 4 section.
- 5 (2) Fifteen percent of the collections of the tax imposed at a
- 6 rate of 4% shall be distributed to cities, villages, and townships
- 7 pursuant to the Glenn Steil state revenue sharing act of 1971, 1971
- 8 PA 140, MCL 141.901 to 141.921.
- 9 (3) Sixty percent of the collections of the tax imposed at a
- 10 rate of 4% shall be deposited in the state school aid fund

- 1 established in section 11 of article IX of the state constitution
- 2 of 1963 and distributed as provided by law. In addition, all of the
- 3 collections of the tax imposed at the additional rate of 2%
- 4 approved by the electors March 15, 1994 shall be deposited in the
- 5 state school aid fund.
- 6 (4) Not less than 27.9% of 25% of the collections of the
- 7 general sales tax imposed at a rate of 4% directly or indirectly on
- 8 fuels sold to propel motor vehicles upon highways, on the sale of
- 9 motor vehicles, and on the sale of the parts and accessories of
- 10 motor vehicles by new and used car businesses, used car businesses,
- 11 accessory dealer businesses, and gasoline station businesses as
- 12 classified by the department of treasury shall be deposited each
- 13 year into the comprehensive transportation fund created in section
- 14 10b of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.660b.
- 15 (5) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013 only, an AN
- 16 amount equal to 18% of the collections of the tax imposed at a rate
- 17 of 4% under this act from the sale of motor fuel, as that term is
- 18 defined in section 4 of the motor fuel tax act, 2000 PA 403, MCL
- 19 207.1004, shall be distributed as follows: TO THE MICHIGAN
- 20 TRANSPORTATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 10 OF 1951 PA 51, MCL
- 21 247.660.
- 22 (a) An amount sufficient to match available federal highway
- 23 funds shall be deposited into the state trunk line fund created in
- 24 section 11 of 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.661, for the purpose of matching
- 25 federal aid highway funds as those federal funds are made available
- 26 to this state, but not less than 39.1% subject to subdivision (c).
- 27 (b) After the distribution under subdivision (a), any

- 1 remaining balance, subject to subdivision (c), shall be distributed
- 2 as follows:
- 3 (i) 66% to the county road commissions of this state, which
- 4 distribution shall be administered under section 12 of 1951 PA 51,
- 5 MCL 247.662.
- 6 (ii) 34% to the cities and villages of this state, which
- 7 distribution shall be administered under section 13 of 1951 PA 51,
- 8 MCL 247.663.
- 9 (c) Funds distributed under this subsection shall not exceed
- 10 <del>\$100,000,000.00.</del>
- 11 (6) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013 only and
- 12 SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, except as
- 13 otherwise limited in this subsection, after the allocations and
- 14 distributions are made pursuant to subsections (2) and (3), an
- 15 amount equal to the collections of the tax imposed at a rate of 4%
- 16 under this act from the sale at retail of aviation fuel and
- 17 aviation products shall be deposited in the state aeronautics fund
- 18 and shall be expended, on appropriation, only for those purposes
- 19 authorized in the aeronautics code of the state of Michigan, 1945
- 20 PA 327, MCL 259.1 to 259.208. Not more than \$10,000,000.00 shall be
- 21 deposited in the state aeronautics fund under this subsection. As
- 22 used in this subsection, "state aeronautics fund" means the state
- 23 aeronautics fund created in section 34 of the aeronautics code of
- 24 the state of Michigan, 1945 PA 327, MCL 259.34.
- 25 (7) An amount equal to the collections of the tax imposed at a
- 26 rate of 4% under this act from the sale at retail of computer
- 27 software as defined in section 1a shall be deposited in the

- 1 Michigan health initiative fund created in section 5911 of the
- 2 public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.5911, and shall be
- 3 considered in addition to, and is not intended as a replacement for
- 4 any other money appropriated to the department of community health.
- 5 The funds deposited in the Michigan health initiative fund on an
- 6 annual basis shall not be less than \$9,000,000.00 or more than
- **7** \$12,000,000.00.
- 8 (8) The balance in the state general fund shall be disbursed
- 9 only on an appropriation or appropriations by the legislature.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
- **11** 1, 2014.
- 12 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- unless Senate Bill No. 6 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into
- **14** law.
