1 PART 1

2 LINE-ITEM APPROPRIATIONS

3 Sec. 101. Subject to the conditions set forth in this act, the
4 amounts listed in this part are appropriated for the state
5 transportation department and certain state purposes designated in
6 this act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, from the
7 funds indicated in this part. The following is a summary of the
8 appropriations in this part:

16 Sec. 1201. It is the intent of the legislature to provide

17 appropriations for the fiscal year ending on September 30, 2015 for

19 appropriations are anticipated to be the same as those for fiscal

20 year 2013-2014, except that the line items will be adjusted for

21 changes in caseload and related costs, federal fund match rates,

22 economic factors, and available revenue. These adjustments will be

23 determined after the January 2014 consensus revenue estimating

2 Sec. 1202. It is the intent of the legislature that the
3 department identify the amounts for normal retirement costs and
4 legacy retirement costs for the fiscal year ending on September 30,
5 2015 for the line items listed in part 1.
