SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 803

A bill to provide for the management, operations, maintenance, restoration, and improvement of the official governor's residence of this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "official residence act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Commission" means the official residence commission
- 5 established in section 4.
- 6 (b) "Department" means the department of technology,
- 7 management, and budget.
- 8 (c) "Fund" means the official residence fund created in

- 1 section 6.
- 2 (d) "Official residence" means the governor's residence and
- 3 grounds in Lansing bounded by Oxford road on the south, Nottingham
- 4 road on the west, Moores river drive on the north, and lots 2 and
- 5 12 of Riverside homes company subdivision no. 1 on the east.
- 6 (e) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 7 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 8 Sec. 3. The official residence shall be under the exclusive
- 9 control of the commission.
- 10 Sec. 4. (1) The official residence commission is established.
- 11 (2) The commission shall consist of the following members:
- 12 (a) The director of the department or his or her designee.
- 13 (b) Two individuals appointed by the governor, at least 1 of
- 14 whom has expertise and experience in operations, maintenance, or
- 15 restoration of historic structures.
- 16 (3) Members of the commission shall serve without
- 17 compensation. However, members of the commission may be reimbursed
- 18 for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance
- 19 of their official duties as members of the commission.
- 20 (4) A majority of the members of the commission constitute a
- 21 quorum for the transaction of business at a meeting of the
- 22 commission. An affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the
- 23 commission is required for official action of the commission.
- 24 (5) The business that the commission may perform shall be
- 25 conducted at a public meeting of the commission held in compliance
- 26 with the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 27 (6) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or

- 1 retained by the commission in the performance of an official
- 2 function is subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442,

- 4 Sec. 5. (1) The commission shall do all of the following:
- 5 (a) Operate and manage the official residence.
- 6 (b) Maintain, restore, and improve the official residence.
- 7 (c) Contract with any person for purposes of procuring goods
- 8 or services or otherwise carrying out the commission's
- 9 responsibilities with regard to the official residence.
- 10 (d) Make recommendations to the governor, the senate, and the
- 11 house of representatives regarding funding for the official
- 12 residence, including, but not limited to, funding from the fund.
- 13 (e) Carry out other responsibilities as provided by law.
- 14 (2) The department shall provide staff to the commission to
- 15 carry out the commission's responsibilities under subsection (1).
- 16 Sec. 6. (1) The official residence fund is created within the
- 17 state treasury.
- 18 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from
- 19 any source for deposit into the fund, including private gifts,
- 20 bequests, and donations. The state treasurer shall direct the
- 21 investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit to the
- 22 fund interest and earnings from fund investments.
- 23 (3) Except as provided in this subsection, money in the fund
- 24 at the close of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund and shall
- 25 not lapse to the general fund. If, at the close of any state fiscal
- year, money in the fund exceeds \$200,000.00, any amount in excess
- of \$200,000.00 shall lapse to the general fund.

- (4) The commission shall be the administrator of the fund for 1
- auditing purposes. 2
- (5) The commission shall expend money from the fund to carry 3
- out its responsibilities under this act.
