SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 188

A bill to amend 1990 PA 271, entitled "Limousine transportation act," by amending section 3 (MCL 257.1903).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Certificate of authority" means a certificate of
- 3 authority issued under the terms of this act unless the context
- 4 indicates otherwise.
- 5 (b) "Department" means the state transportation department.
- 6 (c) "For hire" means the remuneration or reward of any kind,
- 7 paid or promised, either directly or indirectly.
- 8 (d) "Lessor" means a person who leases a limousine OR
- 9 TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY VEHICLE to any other person for the
- 10 transportation of passengers for hire over the public highways of

- 1 this state.
- 2 (e) "Limousine" means a self-propelled motor vehicle used in
- 3 the carrying of passengers and the baggage of the passengers for
- 4 hire upon a public highway of this state with a seating capacity of
- 5 15—8 passengers or less, including the driver. Limousine does not
- 6 include a self-propelled motor vehicle having a seating capacity of
- 7 15-8 passengers or less that is used by or on behalf of an employer
- 8 to transport its employees to and from their place of employment.
- 9 EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ACT, LIMOUSINE DOES NOT
- 10 INCLUDE A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY VEHICLE.
- 11 (f) "Limo carrier of passengers" means a person who, either
- 12 directly or through any device or arrangement, holds himself or
- 13 herself out to the public as willing to undertake for hire to
- 14 transport by limousine from place to place over the public highways
- 15 of this state persons who may choose to employ him or her for that
- 16 purpose.
- 17 (g) "Motor vehicle service and repair act" means Act No. 300
- 18 of the Public Acts of 1974, being sections 257.1301 to 257.1340 of
- 19 the Michigan Compiled Laws. THE MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE AND REPAIR
- 20 ACT, 1974 PA 300, MCL 257.1301 TO 257.1340.
- 21 (h) "Person" means an individual, sole proprietorship,
- 22 partnership, association, corporation, or other legal entity or the
- 23 lessee, trustee, or receiver of any of these entities; this state;
- 24 a city, village, township, or county; the federal government; or an
- 25 employee, officer, or agent of any of these units of government.
- (i) "Public highway" means a highway, road, street, avenue,
- 27 alley, or thoroughfare of any kind, or a bridge, tunnel, or subway

- 1 used by the public.
- 2 (j) "The public" means that THE part or portion of the general
- 3 public which the THAT A limo carrier OF PASSENGERS OR
- 4 TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY DRIVER is ready, able, willing, and
- 5 equipped to serve.
- 6 (k) "Through any device or arrangement" means any and all
- 7 methods, means, agreements, circumstances, operations, or
- 8 subterfuges under which a person undertakes for hire to conduct,
- 9 direct, control, or otherwise perform the transportation of
- 10 passengers by limousine OR TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY VEHICLE
- 11 upon the public highways of this state.
- 12 (1) "TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY" MEANS A PERSON OPERATING
- 13 IN THIS STATE THAT USES A DIGITAL NETWORK TO CONNECT RIDERS TO
- 14 TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY DRIVERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING
- 15 PREARRANGED TRANSPORTATION.
- 16 (M) "TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY DRIVER" MEANS AN
- 17 INDIVIDUAL WHO USES A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY VEHICLE TO
- 18 PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR HIRE TO RIDERS THAT ARE MATCHED
- 19 TO THAT INDIVIDUAL THROUGH A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY'S
- 20 DIGITAL NETWORK, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE INDIVIDUAL IS EMPLOYED
- 21 BY A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY.
- 22 (N) "TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR
- 23 VEHICLE THAT IS BEING OPERATED BY A TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY
- 24 DRIVER.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 26 unless Senate Bill No. 184 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into
- 27 law.
