SENATE BILL NO. 1056

A bill to amend 2006 PA 250, entitled "Money transmission services act," by amending section 4 (MCL 487.1004).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. This act does not apply to any of the following:
- 2 (a) The United States or a department, agency, or
- 3 instrumentality of the United States.
- 4 (b) Money transmission services **THAT ARE** provided by the
- 5 United States postal service POSTAL SERVICE or by a contractor on
- 6 behalf of the United States postal service. POSTAL SERVICE.
- 7 (c) A state, county, city, or any other governmental
- 8 subdivision of a state.
- 9 (d) A depository financial institution, office of an
- 10 international banking corporation, or branch of a foreign bank; a

- 1 bank holding company or subsidiary, as those terms are defined in
- 2 section 2(a)(1) and 2(d) of the bank holding company act of 1956,
- 3 12 USC 1841; a bank service company organized under the bank
- 4 service company act, 12 USC 1861 to 1867; a subsidiary or affiliate
- 5 of a depository financial institution, or a subsidiary or affiliate
- 6 of a holding company of a depository financial institution, if the
- 7 depository financial institution maintains its main office or a
- 8 branch office in this state; a credit union service organization,
- 9 as that term is defined in section 102 of the credit union act,
- 10 2003 PA 215, MCL 490.102; or a corporation organized under the Edge
- 11 act, 12 USC 611 to 633.
- 12 (E) AN AGENT OF AN ENTITY DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (D).
- 13 (F) (e) Electronic AN ELECTRONIC funds transfer of
- 14 governmental benefits for a federal, state, county, or governmental
- 15 agency by a contractor on behalf of the United States or a
- 16 department, agency, or instrumentality of the United States or a
- 17 state or governmental subdivision, agency, or instrumentality of a
- 18 state.
- 19 (G) (f)—A board of trade THAT IS designated as a contract
- 20 market under the commodity exchange act, 7 USC 1 to 27f, or a
- 21 person that in the ordinary course of business provides clearance
- 22 and settlement services for a board of trade, to the extent of its
- 23 operation as or for that board.
- 24 (H) (q)—A registered futures commission merchant under the
- 25 federal commodities laws, to the extent of its operation as a
- 26 merchant.
- 27 (I) (h)—A person that provides clearance or settlement

- 1 services under a registration as a clearing agency or an exemption
- 2 from registration granted under the federal securities laws, to the
- 3 extent of its operation as a provider under this subdivision.
- 4 (J) (i) An operator of a payment system, to the extent that it
- 5 provides processing, clearing, settlement, or other similar
- 6 services between or among persons excluded by UNDER this section in
- 7 connection with wire transfers, credit card transactions, debit
- 8 card transactions, stored value transactions, automated
- 9 clearinghouse transfers, or other similar funds transfers or
- 10 transactions.
- 11 (K) (j) A person **THAT IS** registered as a securities broker-
- 12 dealer under federal or state securities laws, to the extent of its
- 13 operation as a registered broker-dealer.
