HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 579

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 233 (MCL 436.1233).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 233. (1) The commission shall establish uniform prices
- 2 for the sale of alcoholic liquor in state liquor stores and by
- 3 specially designated distributors. The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED
- 4 IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE prices shall—MUST return a gross profit to
- 5 the commission of not less than 51% and not greater than 65%. If
- 6 alcoholic liquor purchased by the commission has not met sales
- 7 standards established by the commission for a period of 6 months,
- 8 the commission may sell the alcoholic liquor at a price to be
- 9 approved by the state administrative board. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE

- 1 PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION AND SUBJECT TO PRICES APPROVED BY THE
- 2 STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION
- 3 SHALL ESTABLISH UNIFORM PRICES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION THAT WILL
- 4 RETURN A GROSS PROFIT TO THE COMMISSION AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 (A) FOR 2018, NOT GREATER THAN 65%.
- 6 (B) FOR 2019, NOT GREATER THAN 64.5%.
- 7 (C) FOR 2020, NOT GREATER THAN 64.5% UNLESS THE 2019 TOTAL
- 8 SALES OF SPIRITS IN THIS STATE INCREASED BY AT LEAST 2% FROM THE
- 9 2018 SALES. IF THE 2019 TOTAL SALES OF SPIRITS IN THIS STATE
- 10 INCREASED AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, BEGINNING WITH THE
- 11 SECOND QUARTERLY PRICE FOR 2020, THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH
- 12 UNIFORM PRICES THAT WILL RETURN A PROFIT OF 64%.
- 13 (D) FOR 2021, NOT GREATER THAN THE PERCENTAGE ESTABLISHED BY
- 14 THE COMMISSION FOR 2020 UNLESS THE 2020 SALES OF SPIRITS IN THIS
- 15 STATE INCREASED BY AT LEAST 2% FROM THE 2019 SALES. IF THE 2020
- 16 SALES OF SPIRITS IN THIS STATE INCREASED AS DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 17 SUBDIVISION, BEGINNING WITH THE SECOND QUARTERLY PRICE FOR 2021,
- 18 THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH UNIFORM PRICES THAT WILL REDUCE THE
- 19 PERCENTAGE OF GROSS PROFIT BY 0.5 FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 20 (E) FOR 2022, NOT GREATER THAN THE PERCENTAGE ESTABLISHED BY
- 21 THE COMMISSION FOR 2021 UNLESS THE 2021 SALES OF SPIRITS IN THIS
- 22 STATE INCREASED BY AT LEAST 2% FROM THE 2020 SALES. IF THE 2021
- 23 SALES OF SPIRITS IN THIS STATE INCREASED AS DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 24 SUBDIVISION, BEGINNING WITH THE SECOND QUARTERLY PRICE FOR 2022,
- 25 THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH UNIFORM PRICES THAT WILL REDUCE THE
- 26 PERCENTAGE OF GROSS PROFIT BY 0.5 FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR.
- 27 (F) FOR 2023 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE PERCENTAGE

- 1 ESTABLISHED IN SUBDIVISION (E).
- 2 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the commission may
- 3 establish by rule prices for the sale of alcoholic liquor to
- 4 hospitals, charitable institutions, and military establishments
- 5 located in this state.
- 6 (3) There shall be allowed a discount of 17% deducted from the
- 7 sale price established by the commission on the sale of SPECIALLY
- 8 DESIGNATED DISTRIBUTORS AND ON-PREMISES LICENSEES ARE ENTITLED TO A
- 9 17% DISCOUNT FROM THE UNIFORM PRICE DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (1)
- 10 ON alcoholic liquor made by the PURCHASED FROM THIS state. liquor
- 11 stores to specially designated distributors and establishments
- 12 licensed to sell for consumption on the premises.
- 13 (4) NOT LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2019 AND EACH FEBRUARY 1
- 14 THEREAFTER, A SMALL DISTILLER OR AN OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE
- 15 SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER MAY FILE AN APPLICATION
- 16 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT TO BE
- 17 CERTIFIED AS A QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER. AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS
- 18 SUBSECTION MUST BE ON A FORM PRESCRIBED AND FURNISHED BY THE
- 19 DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT. THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 20 AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT MAY CHARGE A REASONABLE
- 21 CERTIFICATION FEE.
- 22 (5) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, FOR EACH BOTTLE OF SPIRITS
- 23 PRODUCED BY A QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER OF WHICH AT LEAST 40% OF
- 24 THE BASE DISTILLATE IS DISTILLED FROM GRAIN GROWN AND HARVESTED IN
- 25 THIS STATE AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL
- 26 DEVELOPMENT, THE PRICE FOR EACH BOTTLE MUST RETURN A GROSS PROFIT
- 27 TO THE COMMISSION OF 32.5%.

- 1 (6) THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT SHALL
- 2 CERTIFY THAT AN APPLICANT UNDER SUBSECTION (4) IS A QUALIFIED SMALL
- 3 DISTILLER IF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT
- 4 DETERMINES THAT THE BASE DISTILLATE IS OF THE SMALL DISTILLER OR
- 5 THE OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A
- 6 SMALL DISTILLER IS AT LEAST 40% DISTILLED FROM DISTILLED GRAIN
- 7 GROWN AND HARVESTED IN THIS STATE.
- 8 (7) NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND EACH OCTOBER 1
- 9 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT
- 10 SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE COMMISSION. A REPORT UNDER THIS
- 11 SUBSECTION MUST INCLUDE THE NAME OF EACH QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER
- 12 CERTIFIED UNDER SUBSECTION (6).
- 13 (8) A QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER CERTIFICATE EXPIRES ON
- 14 FEBRUARY 1 FOLLOWING THE DATE OF ISSUANCE.
- 15 (9) A SMALL DISTILLER OR AN OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE
- 16 SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER THAT SUPPLIES FALSE
- 17 INFORMATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT
- 18 OR THE COMMISSION UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 19 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF
- 20 NOT MORE THAN \$3,000.00, OR BOTH. A SMALL DISTILLER OR AN OUT-OF-
- 21 STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL
- 22 DISTILLER THAT SUPPLIES FALSE INFORMATION AS DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 23 SUBSECTION SHALL PAY THE COMMISSION THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE
- 24 GROSS PROFIT THE COMMISSION WOULD HAVE RECEIVED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 25 (1) IF THE SMALL DISTILLER OR THE OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE
- 26 SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER WAS NOT A QUALIFIED
- 27 SMALL DISTILLER, AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION.

- 1 (10) A QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER SHALL KEEP A COMPLETE AND
- 2 ACCURATE SET OF RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS OF ALL TRANSACTIONS PERTAINING
- 3 TO THE OPERATION OF ITS DISTILLERY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 4 RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS OF ALL DISTILLED GRAIN RECEIVED IN OR
- 5 WITHDRAWN FROM THE DISTILLERY, ALL ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORMS AND
- 6 MICHIGAN CERTIFICATION OF ORIGINATION STATEMENTS IN THE QUALIFIED
- 7 SMALL DISTILLER'S POSSESSION, COPIES OF ALL CONTRACTS, AND
- 8 ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORMS RETURNED TO AND SETTLED BY THE QUALIFIED SMALL
- 9 DISTILLER. THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND
- 10 THE COMMISSION MAY EXAMINE THE RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS PERTAINING TO
- 11 THE QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER'S DISTILLED GRAIN HANDLING BUSINESS
- 12 AT ANY TIME DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS.
- 13 (11) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 14 (A) "ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM" MEANS A SCALE WEIGHT TICKET, A LOAD
- 15 SLIP, OR ANY OTHER EVIDENCE OF DEPOSIT ISSUED BY A SMALL DISTILLER
- 16 OR AN OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A
- 17 SMALL DISTILLER OR THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SMALL
- 18 DISTILLER OR THE OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL
- 19 EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER TO A DEPOSITOR THAT IDENTIFIES THE
- 20 DISTILLED GRAIN BEING TRANSFERRED FROM POSSESSION OF THE DEPOSITOR
- 21 TO THE POSSESSION OF THE SMALL DISTILLER OR THE OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY
- 22 THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER.
- 23 (B) "DEPOSITOR" MEANS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 24 (i) A PERSON THAT DELIVERS DISTILLED GRAIN TO A SMALL
- 25 DISTILLER OR AN OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL
- 26 EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER FOR STORAGE, PROCESSING, SHIPMENT,
- 27 OR SALE AND THAT HAS TITLE TO DISTILLED GRAIN AT THE TIME OF

- 1 DELIVERY.
- 2 (ii) A PERSON THAT OWNS OR THAT IS THE LEGAL HOLDER OF AN
- 3 ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM ISSUED BY A DEPOSITOR FOR DISTILLED GRAIN.
- 4 (C) "DISTILLED GRAIN" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 5 (i) DRY BARLEY.
- (ii) MALTED BARLEY. 6
- 7 (iii) OATS.
- (iv) A SMALL GRAIN. 8
- 9 (v) A CEREAL GRAIN.
- 10 (vi) POTATO.
- 11 (vii) CORN.
- 12 (viii) FRUIT.
- 13 (ix) SUGAR BEETS.
- 14 (x) HONEY.
- (D) "MICHIGAN CERTIFICATION OF ORIGINATION STATEMENT" MEANS A 15
- 16 SIGNED STATEMENT FROM A DEPOSITOR OR PRODUCER ON AN ACKNOWLEDGEMENT
- 17 FORM THAT DEPOSITED DISTILLED GRAIN WAS GROWN AND HARVESTED IN THIS
- 18 STATE.
- 19 (E) "QUALIFIED SMALL DISTILLER" MEANS A SMALL DISTILLER OR AN
- 20 OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT IS THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL
- 21 DISTILLER CERTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL
- DEVELOPMENT UNDER THIS SECTION AS HAVING AT LEAST 40% OF THE BASE 22
- 23 DISTILLATE OF THE SMALL DISTILLER OR THE OUT-OF-STATE ENTITY THAT
- 24 IS THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENT OF A SMALL DISTILLER DISTILLED FROM
- 25 DISTILLED GRAIN GROWN AND HARVESTED IN THIS STATE.
