## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 5635

## A bill to amend 1911 PA 44, entitled

"An act to create a state board of equalization; to prescribe its powers and duties; to provide that said board shall be furnished with certain information by the several boards of supervisors and by the state tax commission; to provide for meeting the expense authorized by this act, and to repeal all acts or parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 209.5), as amended by 2001 PA 36.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) At the regular meeting of the boards of
- 2 commissioners of the several counties held DURING THE PERIOD
- 3 BEGINNING on the Tuesday following the second Monday in April AND
- 4 ENDING ON THE THIRD MONDAY IN APRIL each year, the boards of
- 5 commissioners shall equalize the assessment rolls in the manner
- 6 provided by law. The equalization shall MUST be completed before
- 7 the first Monday in May.

- 1 (2) Before these meetings, each assessing officer shall add up
- 2 the columns of his or her assessment roll, enumerating the number
- 3 of acres of land and the value of the real and personal property
- 4 assessed, to show the aggregate of each. The director of the tax or
- 5 equalization department of each county shall prepare a tabular
- 6 statement from the aggregates of the several rolls of the number of
- 7 acres of land and the value of the personal property and each
- 8 classification of real property in each township and city as
- 9 assessed, and also the aggregate valuation of the personal property
- 10 and each classification of real property appearing on each roll as
- 11 equalized by the county board of commissioners pursuant to section
- 12 34 of the general property tax act, 1893 PA 206, MCL 211.34. The
- 13 director of the tax or equalization department shall make a
- 14 certified copy of the tabular statement, signed by the chairperson
- 15 and clerk of the county board of commissioners and the director of
- 16 the tax or equalization department, and shall transmit the
- 17 statement to the secretary of the state tax commission on or before
- 18 the first Monday in May, who shall present the statement to the
- 19 state board of equalization immediately following its organization.
- 20 The statement and copy of the statement shall MUST not embrace any
- 21 property assessed under laws enacted pursuant to section 5 of
- 22 article 9-IX of the state constitution of 1963, or on which
- 23 specific taxes are imposed, or for which alternative means of
- 24 taxation in lieu of general ad valorem taxation are provided by
- **25** law.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 27 after the date it is enacted into law.
