## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 310. (1) This chapter shall not be construed to DOES NOT prohibit or make unlawful the ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) THE operation of a game of skill or chance pursuant to

- 17 PLAYER OR PARTICIPANT IN THE GAME OR CONTEST.
- 18 (ii) THE PERFORMANCE OF THE PLAYER OR PARTICIPANT RELATIVE TO
- 19 THE PERFORMANCE OF OTHERS IS DETERMINATIVE OF THE OUTCOME.
- 20 (iii) THE PRIZES AND AWARDS OFFERED TO WINNING PARTICIPANTS
- 21 ARE ESTABLISHED AND MADE KNOWN TO THE PARTICIPANTS IN ADVANCE OF
- 22 THE GAME OR CONTEST.
- 23 (B) THE GAME OR CONTEST IS A FANTASY OR SIMULATION SPORTS GAME
- 24 OR CONTEST THAT SATISFIES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
- 25 (i) THE VALUE OF ALL PRIZES AND AWARDS OFFERED TO WINNING GAME
- 26 PARTICIPANTS IS ESTABLISHED AND MADE KNOWN TO THE GAME PARTICIPANTS
- 27 IN ADVANCE OF THE FANTASY GAME.

- 1 (ii) ALL WINNING OUTCOMES REFLECT THE RELATIVE KNOWLEDGE AND
- 2 SKILL OF GAME PARTICIPANTS AND ARE DETERMINED PREDOMINANTLY BY
- 3 ACCUMULATED STATISTICAL RESULTS OF THE PERFORMANCE OF INDIVIDUALS,
- 4 INCLUDING ATHLETES IN THE CASE OF SPORTING EVENTS.
- 5 (iii) A WINNING OUTCOME IS NOT BASED ON THE SCORE, POINT
- 6 SPREAD, OR PERFORMANCE OF A SINGLE TEAM OR COMBINATION OF TEAMS OR
- 7 ON ANY SINGLE PERFORMANCE OF AN INDIVIDUAL ATHLETE OR PLAYER IN A
- 8 SINGLE EVENT.
- 9 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ATHLETIC EVENT" AND "ATHLETIC
- 10 GAME OR CONTEST" MEAN A REAL WORLD PROFESSIONAL, COLLEGIATE, OR
- 11 NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED SPORTS GAME, CONTEST, OR COMPETITION THAT
- 12 INVOLVES THE PHYSICAL EXERTION AND SKILL OF THE PARTICIPATING
- 13 INDIVIDUAL ATHLETES, AS TO WHICH EACH PARTICIPANT IS PHYSICALLY
- 14 PRESENT AT THE LOCATION IN WHICH THE SPORTS GAME, CONTEST, OR
- 15 COMPETITION OCCURS, AND THE OUTCOME OF THE SPORTS GAME, CONTEST, OR
- 16 COMPETITION IS DIRECTLY DEPENDENT ON THE PERFORMANCE OF THE
- 17 PARTICIPATING ATHLETES.
