SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4035

A bill to prohibit a local unit of government from enacting or enforcing an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that regulates a dog based upon the breed or perceived breed of the dog; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain local governmental entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) A local unit of government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that regulates a dog based upon the dog's breed or perceived breed. This subsection does not prohibit a local unit of government from enacting an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that does any of the following:
 - (a) Places restrictions or imposes additional requirements on

- 1 dogs or dog owners.
- 2 (b) Regulates dogs determined to be dangerous or potentially
- 3 dangerous by the local unit of government. An ordinance, policy,
- 4 resolution, or rule enacted under this subdivision may include, but
- 5 is not limited to, all of the following:
- 6 (i) A definition of "dangerous dog", or a similar term or
- 7 terms, to be used in determining that a dog is dangerous or
- 8 potentially dangerous.
- ${f 9}$ (ii) Rules and procedures that provide for a process by which a
- 10 dog is determined to be dangerous or potentially dangerous.
- 11 (iii) Requirements for the ownership or possession of a dog that
- 12 has been determined to be dangerous or potentially dangerous.
- 13 (iv) Penalties for a violation of the ordinance, policy,
- 14 resolution, or rule by the owner or possessor of a dog that has
- 15 been determined to be dangerous or potentially dangerous.
- 16 (2) As used in this act, "local unit of government" means a
- 17 county, city, village, or township.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 19 date it is enacted into law.
