SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4112

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 905a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 905a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- 2 licensed under this act to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption on
- 3 or off the licensed premises at retail shall post in a conspicuous
- 4 location a sign informing the public of the effects of alcohol
- 5 consumption during pregnancy. The sign must contain the message:
- 6 "Pregnancy and alcohol do not mix. Drinking alcoholic beverages
- 7 during pregnancy can cause birth defects.". The commission shall
- 8 include the message required under this subsection in the sign
- 9 furnished by the commission under section 701.





- 1 (2) If the person described in subsection (1) sells alcoholic 2 liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, instead of posting 3 a sign the person may place the message required by subsection (1) on a menu. 4
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days 5 after the date it is enacted into law. 6
