

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4303**

A bill to provide for the official time followed in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) If the United States Congress amends 15 USC 260a
2 to authorize states to observe daylight saving time year-round, it
3 is the intent of the legislature that daylight saving time shall be
4 the year-round standard time of this state and all of its political
5 subdivisions in that part of this state that is in the Eastern
6 Standard Time zone and in that part of this state that is in the
7 Central Standard Time zone.

8 (2) It is the intent of the legislature that the time change
9 described in subsection (1) take effect only if all of the



1 following states observe daylight saving time year-round:

2 (a) Wisconsin.

3 (b) Illinois.

4 (c) Indiana.

5 (d) Ohio.

6 (e) Pennsylvania.

7 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
8 date it is enacted into law.
