SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5601

A bill to amend 1967 PA 150, entitled "Michigan military act,"

by amending section 182 (MCL 32.582).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 182. (1) The governor as commander in chief, commander-

2 in-chief may prescribe the award of medals and other suitable means

3 of public recognition for distinguished service, longevity, acts of

4 valor, or meritorious achievement. The awards may be made to

5 members of the organized militia of this state or to other

6 individuals, who are not members of the organized militia, who have

 ${f 7}$ rendered appropriate service to the military establishment. The

8 adjutant general shall develop and publish rules to carry out this

9 provision.subsection.





- 1 (2) The adjutant general is authorized to award, in the name
- 2 of the legislature, the "Michigan Vietnam veteran recognition
- 3 certificate". The adjutant general, in consultation with the
- 4 director of the Michigan veterans affairs agency, shall develop and
- 5 publish rules to carry out this subsection. All of the following
- 6 apply to the certificate:
- 7 (a) An individual may be awarded the certificate if the
- 8 individual meets all of the following requirements:
- 9 (i) The individual is a citizen of this state or was a citizen
- 10 of this state while serving in the Armed Forces of the United
- 11 States.
- 12 (ii) The individual was honorably discharged or released under
- 13 honorable circumstances.
- 14 (iii) The individual served during the Vietnam War era.
- 15 (b) The certificate created under this subsection also
- 16 includes the option of a special designation, as developed by the
- 17 department of military and veterans affairs, recognizing
- 18 individuals who were exposed to dioxin or phenoxy herbicides during
- 19 their service. To receive this designation, an individual must
- 20 demonstrate in a form and manner prescribed by the department of
- 21 military and veterans affairs that while serving in the Armed
- 22 Forces of the United States, he or she was exposed to dioxin or
- 23 phenoxy herbicides, as evidenced by a medical diagnosis of a
- 24 disease associated with dioxin or phenoxy herbicides and any other
- 25 proof required by the adjutant general.
- (c) An individual shall not be awarded more than 1
- 27 certificate.
- 28 (d) If the certificate recipient is deceased, the certificate
- 29 may be presented to a designated representative of the deceased.



- 1 (3) As used in this section:
- 2 (a) "Armed Forces of the United States" means the United
- 3 States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, and Coast Guard,
- 4 including the Michigan National Guard and reserve components.
- 5 (b) "Certificate" means the Michigan Vietnam veteran
- 6 recognition certificate.
- 7 (c) "Vietnam War era" means the period beginning on February
- $8\quad$ 28, 1961 and ending on May 7, 1975.
