## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4473

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by amending the heading of chapter XXA and by adding section 145s.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	CHAPTER XXA
2	VULNERABLE ADULTS AND ELDER ADULTS
3	Sec. 145s. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
4	person who assaults another person that he or she knows or
5	reasonably should know is an elder adult or vulnerable adult is
6	guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more
7	than 1 year or a fine of up to \$1,000.00, or both.
8	(2) If a violation of subsection (1) causes physical injury,





- 1 pain, or mental suffering, the person is guilty of a felony
- 2 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a fine of
- 3 not more than \$5,000.00, or both.
- 4 (3) If a violation of subsection (1) causes serious impairment
- 5 of a body function, the person is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 6 imprisonment for not more than 15 years or a fine of not more than
- 7 \$10,000.00, or both.
- 8 (4) If a violation of subsection (1) causes the death of the
- 9 other person, the person is guilty of a felony punishable by
- 10 imprisonment for not more than 25 years or a fine of not more than
- 11 \$25,000.00, or both.
- 12 (5) A person who restrains an elder adult or a vulnerable
- 13 adult by the use of violence, menace, fraud, or deceit is guilty of
- 14 a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a
- 15 fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both. This subsection does not
- 16 apply to a staff member of a health facility or agency who utilizes
- 17 a restraint in accordance with the laws of this state and any
- 18 federal law or regulation applicable to the operation of the health
- 19 facility or agency. As used in this subsection, "health facility or
- 20 agency" means that term as defined in section 20106 of the public
- 21 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20106.
- 22 (6) This section does not prohibit a person from being charged
- 23 with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of law
- 24 arising out of the same transaction as the violation of this
- 25 section.
- 26 (7) The court may order a term of imprisonment imposed for a
- 27 violation of this section to be served consecutively to a term of
- 28 imprisonment imposed for any other crime, including any other
- 29 violation of law arising out of the same transaction as the

- 1 violation of this section.
- 2 (8) As used in this section:
- 3 (a) "Elder adult" means a person who is 80 years of age or 4 older.
- 5 (b) "Restrains" means to restrict a person's movements or to
- 6 confine the person so as to interfere with that person's liberty
- 7 without that person's consent or without legal authority. The
- 8 restraint does not have to exist for any particular length of time
- 9 and may be related or incidental to the commission of other
- 10 criminal acts.
- 11 (c) "Serious impairment of a body function" means that term as
- 12 defined in section 58c of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300,
- 13 MCL 257.58c.
- 14 (9) If a local area agency on aging becomes aware of a
- 15 violation of this section, the local area agency on aging shall
- 16 promptly report the violation to the department of health and human
- 17 services.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
