## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6118

A bill to amend 1986 PA 268, entitled "Legislative council act,"

(MCL 4.1101 to 4.1901) by adding section 114.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 114. (1) Under the Michigan legislative state medal
- 2 program created in section 113, the legislature may award the
- 3 Michigan legislative medal of freedom as the highest civilian medal
- 4 of this state.
- 5 (2) All of the following apply to the awarding of the medal:
- 6 (a) The medal may be awarded to a living or deceased
- 7 individual in recognition of either of the following:
- 8 (i) A valorous or heroic deed performed in the saving of a
- 9 life.





- 1 (ii) Injury or death, or the threat of injury or death,
- 2 incurred in the service of this state or the individual's
- 3 community, or on behalf of the health, welfare, or safety of other
- 4 individuals in this state.
- 5 (b) The legislature may award the medal by concurrent
- 6 resolution.
- 7 (c) Upon passage of the concurrent resolution described in
- 8 subdivision (b), the speaker of the house of representatives and
- 9 the senate majority leader shall award the medal in the presence of
- 10 the legislator or legislators who sponsored the concurrent
- 11 resolution and the representative and senator of the district where
- 12 the individual being awarded the medal resides or, if the
- 13 individual is deceased, last resided.
- 14 (3) The council administrator, or his or her designee, shall
- 15 determine the design of the medal consistent with this subsection.
- 16 The design of the medal must meet all of the following
- 17 requirements:
- 18 (a) Be able to be worn around the neck.
- 19 (b) Be a circle that is 5 inches in diameter and 0.04 inches
- 20 thick.
- 21 (c) Be made of sterling silver and be plated with not less
- 22 than 18-karat gold.
- 23 (d) The front side of the medal must include all of the
- 24 following, arranged in the following order from the top of the
- 25 medal to the bottom:
- 26 (i) "Michigan Legislative Medal of Freedom" printed in an arch.
- 27 (ii) A raised print of the eastern facade of the State Capitol
- 28 Building, including the State Capitol Building's dome, northern
- 29 chamber and steps, and southern chamber and steps.



- 1 (iii) The name of the medal recipient.
- 2 (iv) The year the medal was presented.
- 3 (e) The back side of the medal must include all of the
- 4 following, arranged in the following order from the top of the
- 5 medal to the bottom:
- 6 (i) "Michigan Legislative Medal of Freedom" printed in an arch.
- 7 ( $\ddot{u}$ ) The name of the medal recipient.
- 8 (iii) A raised print of the United States flag crossed with this
- 9 state's flag.
- 10 (iv) The phrase "The State of Michigan".
- 11 (v) The year that the deed for which the medal was awarded was
- 12 performed.
- 13 (4) As used in this section, "medal" means the Michigan
- 14 legislative medal of freedom described in subsection (1).
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 16 unless all of the following bills of the 101st Legislature are
- 17 enacted into law:
- 18 (a) House Bill No. 6119.
- 19 (b) House Bill No. 6120.
- 20 (c) House Bill No. 6121.
