SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 812

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 20199 (MCL 333.20199) and by adding part 216A.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 20199. (1) Except as **otherwise** provided in subsection (2)
- 2 or section 20142, this article, a person who violates this article
- 3 or a rule promulgated or an order issued under this article is
- 4 guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than
- 5 \$1,000.00 for each day the violation continues or, in case of for a
- 6 violation of sections 20551 to 20554, a fine of not more than
- 7 \$1,000.00 for each occurrence.
- 8 (2) A person who violates sections 20181 to 20184 is guilty of

- 2 PART 216A. SPECIALIZED LABORATORIES
- 3 Sec. 21651. (1) As used in this part:
- 4 (a) "Interventional kidney access laboratory" means a
- 5 facility, other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient
- 6 facility, in which interventional diagnostic and therapeutic
- 7 procedures for kidney disease and cardiovascular disease are
- 8 performed on patients on an ambulatory basis. Interventional kidney
- 9 access laboratory does not include a facility that provides
- 10 dialysis treatment, maintenance, or training to patients or patient
- 11 caregivers on an ambulatory or home-care basis.
- 12 (b) "Interventional pain management laboratory" means a
- 13 facility, other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient
- 14 facility, in which interventional diagnostic and therapeutic
- 15 procedures for pain management and cardiovascular disease are
- 16 performed on patients on an ambulatory basis.
- 17 (c) "Interventional vascular laboratory" means a facility,
- 18 other than a hospital or freestanding surgical outpatient facility,
- 19 in which interventional diagnostic and therapeutic procedures for
- 20 vascular disease, kidney disease, arterial disease, and vein
- 21 disease are performed on patients on an ambulatory basis.
- 22 Interventional vascular laboratory does not include a facility that
- 23 provides dialysis treatment, maintenance, or training to patients
- 24 or patient caregivers on an ambulatory or home-care basis.
- 25 (d) "Specialized laboratory" means an interventional kidney
- 26 access laboratory, interventional pain management laboratory, or
- 27 interventional vascular laboratory.
- 28 (2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and
- 29 principles of construction applicable to all articles in this code

- 1 and part 201 contains definitions applicable to this part.
- 2 Sec. 21653. (1) Beginning 180 days after the effective date of
- 3 the amendatory act that added this section, a person that
- 4 establishes or operates a specialized laboratory shall register the
- 5 specialized laboratory with the department of health and human
- 6 services on a form and in a manner required by the department of
- 7 health and human services.
- 8 (2) On the receipt of an application and payment of a \$250.00
- 9 registration fee, the department of health and human services shall
- 10 register a specialized laboratory under this part. A registration
- 11 is valid for 1 year and may be renewed on application and payment
- 12 of the fee described in this subsection.
- 13 Sec. 21655. Both of the following apply to a person that
- 14 violates this part:
- 15 (a) The person is subject to an administrative fine of \$100.00
- 16 for each day that the violation continues. The department of health
- 17 and human services shall provide notice and an opportunity for a
- 18 hearing in the same manner as provided in section 20166.
- 19 (b) The person is quilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine
- 20 of not more than \$5,000.00.
