A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

by amending section 232a (MCL 750.232a), as amended by 2023 PA 18.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 232a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person
- ${f 2}$ An individual who obtains a firearm in violation of section 2 of
- 3 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.422, is guilty of a misdemeanor felony
- 4 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days 2 years or a
- 5 fine of not more than \$100.00, \$1,000.00, or both.
- 6 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to a person who obtained a
- 7 pistol in violation of section 2 of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.422, before
- 8 March 28, 1991, who has not been convicted of that violation, and
- 9 who obtains a license as required under section 2 of 1927 PA 372,





- 1 MCL 28.422, within 90 days after March 28, 1991.
- (2) (3) A person An individual who intentionally makes a
 material false statement on an application for a license to
 purchase a firearm under section 2 of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.422, is
- 5 quilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4
- 6 years or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 7 (3) (4) A person An individual who uses or attempts to use
- 8 false identification or the identification of another person
- 9 individual to purchase a firearm, or who otherwise knowingly
- 10 attempts to purchase a firearm in violation of the laws of this
- 11 state, is guilty of a misdemeanor, felony, punishable by
- 12 imprisonment for not more than 90 days 2 years or a fine of not
- 13 more than \$100.00, \$1,000.00, or both.
- 14 (4) If an individual engaged in the sale of firearms has
- 15 knowledge of an attempt to purchase a firearm in violation of the
- 16 laws of this state from that individual, the individual shall
- 17 notify a law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the
- 18 attempted illegal purchase about the attempted illegal purchase
- 19 within 24 hours of the attempted purchase. An individual who fails
- 20 to notify law enforcement as required under this section is quilty
