SCHOOL BUS DESTRUCTION

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4155 AS INTRODUCED 1-17-95

The bill would amend the Michigan Penal Code to create special penalties for malicious destruction of a school bus. It would be a felony punishable by imprisonment for up to five years and a fine of up to \$5,000 to intentionally damage a school bus so that a health or safety hazard was created for anyone occupying that bus. The term "school bus" would include both school buses and school transportation vehicles, as defined by the vehicle code (a "school transportation vehicle" would have to be marked as such in order for the bill to apply). The bill would take effect August 1, 1995.
