## **ANIMAL CARCASS REMOVAL**

### **A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4267 AS INTRODUCED 2-1-95**

The bill would require the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to remove the carcass of a deer, bear, elk, or moose from the traveled portion or the shoulder of any public roadway or bridge in the state. The DNR could enter into a contract with a county board of commissioners to have them carry out these responsibilities for reasonable compensation (as negotiated between the department and county).
