A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4935 AS INTRODUCED 6-7-95

The bill would amend the School Code to eliminate provisions that allow a school district to charge tuition to students who reside in another school district. (Tuition would still be permitted if the students lived outside the state.) The bill also would require a school district in which a nonresident student enrolled to notify the student's district of residence within 30 days after the student's enrollment. The bill is tie-barred to House Bill 4936, which would amend the State School Aid Act to make complementary amendments. These would include specifying that a student attending a district outside of his or her district of residence would be counted in membership in the educating district and specifying that the educating district would not need the approval of the pupil's district of residence to count the student in membership. Approval currently is required from the district of residence.
