Senate Bill 1162 (Substitute S-1 as reported) Sponsor: Senator George A. McManus, Jr. Committee: Agriculture and Forestry

CONTENT

The bill would amend the Michigan Consumer Protection Act to provide that the term "trade or commerce" would not include an employer's provision of rent-free housing to an employee as a benefit or condition of employment. (The Act provides that, "Unfair, unconscionable, or deceptive methods, acts or practices in the conduct of trade or commerce are unlawful...".) "Rent-free housing" would include premises for which a reasonable fee for use of utilities was charged, if no other fee were charged.
