ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4662

AN ACT to amend section 12 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended "An act to establish and operate a state lottery; to create a bureau of state lottery; to prescribe its powers and duties; to prescribe certain powers and duties of other state departments and agencies; to license and regulate sales agents; to create the state lottery fund; to provide for the distribution of lottery revenues and earnings; to provide for an appropriation; and to provide penalties," being section 432.12 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 12 of Act No. 239 of the Public Acts of 1972, being section 432.12 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 12. (1) As nearly as is practicable until January 1, 1999, not less than 45% of the total annual revenue accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be apportioned for payment of prizes to the holders of winning tickets or shares.

(2) After January 1, 1999, 45% of the total revenue shall be apportioned for payment of prizes.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
