AN ACT to amend section 9121 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled "An act to protect the environment and natural resources of the state; to codify, revise, consolidate, and classify laws relating to the environment and natural resources of the state; to regulate the discharge of certain substances into the environment; to regulate the use of certain lands, waters, and other natural resources of the state; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and officials; to provide for certain charges, fees, and assessments; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; to repeal certain parts of this act on a specific date; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as added by Act No. 60 of the Public Acts of 1995, being section 324.9121 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 9121 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as added by Act No. 60 of the Public Acts of 1995, being section 324.9121 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9121. A person who owns land that is not in compliance with this part and who, after notice, refuses to implement and maintain soil erosion and sedimentation control measures in conformance with this part is responsible for a state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than \$500.00.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
