



HOUSE BILL No. 4022

January 11, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Clack and referred to the Committee on Human Services.

A bill to amend Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled as amended "The social welfare act," as amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 44a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 280 of the Public Acts of 1939, as
2 amended, being sections 400.1 to 400.119b of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 44a to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 44A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE SATURDAY OFFICE
6 HOURS IN EACH LOCAL OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT TO ACCOMMODATE
7 EMPLOYED RECIPIENTS OF AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN.
8 THE SATURDAY OFFICE HOURS SHALL BE LIMITED TO RECIPIENTS WHO ARE
9 PARTICIPATING 25 HOURS OR MORE A WEEK IN COMMUNITY SERVICE,

1 EMPLOYMENT, OR TRAINING UNDER A SOCIAL CONTRACT OR THE MICHIGAN
2 OPPORTUNITY AND SKILLS TRAINING PROGRAM.
