

## **HOUSE BILL No. 4032**

January 11, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Agee and Baade and referred to the Committee n Education.

A bill to amend section 14 of Act No. 2 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended "Uniform budgeting and accounting act," being section 141.434 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 14 of Act No. 2 of the Public Acts of 2 1968, being section 141.434 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is 3 amended to read as follows:

  Sec. 14. (1) Unless EXCEPT AS otherwise provided by law,
- is charter, resolution, or ordinance, the chief administrative offi-6 cer shall have final responsibility for budget preparation, pre-7 sentation of the budget to the legislative body, and the control 8 of expenditures under the budget and the general appropriations 9 act.

- 1 (2) Unless another person is designated by charter, the
  2 chief administrative officer in each local unit shall prepare the
  3 recommended annual budget for the ensuing fiscal year in the
  4 manner provided in sections 15 to 20a. The budgetary centers of
  5 the local unit shall provide to the chief administrative officer
  6 information which THAT the chief administrative officer consid7 ers necessary and essential to the preparation of a budget for
  8 the ensuing fiscal period for presentation to the local unit's
  9 legislative body. Each administrative officer or employee of a
  10 budgetary center shall comply promptly with a request for infor-
- (3) The chief administrative officer shall transmit the rec13 ommended budget to the legislative body according to an appropri14 ate time schedule developed by the local unit. The schedule
  15 shall allow adequate time for review by the legislative body
  16 before commencement of the budget year. The recommended budget,
  17 when transmitted by the chief administrative officer, shall be
  18 accompanied by a suggested general appropriations act to imple19 ment the budget. The suggested general appropriations act shall
  20 fulfill the requirements of section 16.

II mation which THAT the chief administrative officer makes.

- 21 (4) The recommended budget transmitted by the chief adminis-22 trative officer shall be considered by the legislative body.
- (5) The chief administrative officer shall furnish to the legislative body information the legislative body requires for proper consideration of the recommended budget. This may include expenditure and revenue data on the local unit's most recently completed fiscal year. Before final passage of a general

lappropriations act by the legislative body, a public hearing shall be held as required by Act No. 43 of the Public Acts of the Second Extra Session of 1903, being sections 141.411 to 141.415 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, and THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, as amended, being sections 15.261 to 15.275 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. EACH CALENDAR YEAR, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT OR AN INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL CONDUCT THE PUBLIC HEARING PREQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION BEFORE THE LATER OF THE FOLLOWING 10 DATES:

- (A) JULY 1.
- (B) THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE ANNUAL STATE SCHOOL AID APPROPRIA-
- (6) The responsibilities and duties imposed by this section by upon the chief administrative officer shall be discharged by the fiscal officer in a local unit which. THAT has not elected or designated a chief administrative officer.
