



HOUSE BILL No. 4141

January 17, 1995, Introduced by Rep. McBryde and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, entitled as amended "The insurance code of 1956," as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 3406f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 3406f to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 3406F. AN INSURER THAT DELIVERS, ISSUES FOR DELIVERY,
6 OR RENEWS IN THIS STATE AN EXPENSE-INCURRED HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR
7 SURGICAL POLICY OR CERTIFICATE SHALL OFFER TO PROVIDE COVERAGE TO
8 AN INSURED'S CHILD UNDER THE INSURED'S POLICY OR CERTIFICATE
9 UNTIL DECEMBER 31 OF THE CALENDAR YEAR IN WHICH THE CHILD BECOMES

1 25 YEARS OF AGE REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THE CHILD IS
2 CONSIDERED A DEPENDENT UNDER SECTION 152 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE
3 CODE OF 1986, 26 U.S.C. 152, IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ARE MET:

4 (A) THE CHILD IS A CHILD BY BIRTH OR ADOPTION OF THE
5 INSURED.

6 (B) THE CHILD IS ENROLLED AS A FULL-TIME STUDENT.

7 (C) THE CHILD IS UNMARRIED.
