



HOUSE BILL No. 4293

February 2, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Ryan, Llewellyn, Byl, Bankes, Gnodtke, Jellema, Geiger, Green, LeTarte, Whyman, Dolan, Brackenridge, Dobronski, Martinez, Voorhees, Bullard, DeLange, Leland, Bobier, Rhead, Gustafson and Perricone and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend section 7 of Act No. 246 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled

"An act to establish and provide a civil service system in certain townships; to create a civil service commission, and to prescribe the duties thereof; to provide certain exemptions from and classifications in civil service; to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to prescribe the manner of adoption of this act by townships,"

being section 38.457 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 7 of Act No. 246 of the Public Acts of
2 1965, being section 38.457 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 7. (1) The commission shall hold A regular ~~meetings~~
5 MEETING at least ~~once a month~~ QUARTERLY. THE COMMISSION SHALL
6 HOLD A SPECIAL MEETING AT THE REQUEST OF A COMMISSIONER. The

1 commission shall adopt its own rules of procedure and shall keep
2 a record of ~~the~~ ITS proceedings.

3 (2) The business ~~which~~ THAT the commission ~~may perform~~
4 PERFORMS shall be conducted at a public meeting of the commission
5 held in compliance with THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT, Act No. 267 of the
6 Public Acts of 1976, being sections 15.261 to 15.275 of the
7 Michigan Compiled Laws. Public notice of the time, date, and
8 place of the meeting shall be given in the manner required by Act
9 No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976.

10 (3) Except for the records listed in section 8(i), a writing
11 prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or retained by the
12 commission in the performance of an official function shall be
13 made available to the public in compliance with THE FREEDOM OF
14 INFORMATION ACT, Act No. 442 of the Public Acts of 1976, being
15 sections 15.231 to 15.246 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
