

HOUSE BILL No. 4488

February 28, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Hammerstrom, London, Wetters, McBryde, Brewer, Law, Kaza, Hill, Dalman, Hanley, Goschka, Palamara, Willard, Kukuk, Bodem, Rocca, Jellema, Dobb, Galloway, Jamian and Brackenridge and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of 1974, entitled

"Youth rehabilitation services act,"

as amended by Act No. 76 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 803.302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of 2 1974, as amended by Act No. 76 of the Public Acts of 1988, being 3 section 803.302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read 4 as follows:
- 5 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 6 (a) "Department" means the state department of social 7 services.
 - (b) "State ward" means either of the following:

(i) A person accepted for care by the department who is at 2 least 12 years of age at the time committed to the department by 3 the juvenile division of a probate court under section 18(1)(e) 4 of chapter XIIA of Act No. 288 of the Public Acts of 1939, -as 5 amended, being section 712A.18 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, if 6 the court acquired jurisdiction over the person pursuant to sec-7 tion 2(a) or (d) of chapter XIIA of Act No. 288 of the Public 8 Acts of 1939, as amended, being section 712A.2 of the Michigan 9 Compiled Laws, and if the act for which the youth is committed 10 occurred before his or her seventeenth birthday. (ii) A person accepted for care by the department who is at 1 i 12 least -15 14 years of age at the time committed to the depart-13 ment by the court of general criminal jurisdiction under section 14 1 of chapter IX of the code of criminal procedure, Act No. 175 of 15 the Public Acts of 1927, being section 769.1 of the Michigan 16 Compiled Laws, and if the act for which the youth is committed 17 occurred before his or her seventeenth birthday. Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless 18 19 all of the following bills of the 88th Legislature are enacted 20 into law: (a) Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. ___ (request 21 22 no. 01932'95). (b) Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. ____ (request 23 24 no. 01932'95 a). (c) Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. (request 26 no. 01932'95 b).

(d) Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. ____ (request 2 no. 01932'95 c).
