



HOUSE BILL No. 4798

May 10, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Varga and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend section 25 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled as amended "State license fee act," as amended by Act No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 338.2225 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 25 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of
2 1979, as amended by Act No. 461 of the Public Acts of 1988, being
3 section 338.2225 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to
4 read as follows:

5 Sec. 25. Fees for a person licensed or seeking licensure as
6 a cosmetologist, manicurist, ESTHETICIAN, electrologist, or
7 instructor, or a person licensed or seeking licensure to operate
8 a ~~cosmetological~~ COSMETOLOGY establishment or school of
9 cosmetology or seeking a student registration or transfer, or

1 seeking a permit to conduct an apprenticeship program under
 2 article 12 of the occupational code, being sections 339.1201 to
 3 339.1218 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are as follows:

5 (i) Apprenticeship program.....\$ 25.00
 6 (ii) Cosmetologist, manicurist, ESTHETICIAN, electrolo-
 7 gist, or instructor..... 10.00
 8 (iii) ~~Cosmetological~~ COSMETOLOGY establishment..... 25.00
 9 (iv) School of cosmetology..... 100.00

11 (i) Complete examination for cosmetologist, manicurist,
 12 ESTHETICIAN, electrologist, or instructor..... 25.00
 13 (ii) Written portion only..... 15.00
 14 (iii) Practical portion only..... 15.00
 15 (iv) Examination review..... 20.00

17 (i) Cosmetologist, manicurist, ESTHETICIAN, electrolo-
 18 gist, or instructor..... 12.00

 20 (iii) School of cosmetology..... 100.00
 21 (d) Student registration or transfer fee..... 5.00
