



HOUSE BILL No. 4820

May 11, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Baade, Porreca, Pitoniak, Harder, McBryde, Goschka, DeMars and DeHart and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931,
entitled as amended
"The Michigan penal code,"
as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 316a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 316a to read as follows:
4 SEC. 316A. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS
5 ACT, A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY OR MALICIOUSLY BURNS A BUILDING OR
6 OTHER REAL PROPERTY AND BY THAT BURNING CAUSES THE DEATH OF AN
7 INDIVIDUAL IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND SHALL BE PUNISHED BY
8 IMPRISONMENT FOR LIFE WITHOUT PAROLE.

1 (2) A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT IMPOSED UNDER SUBSECTION (1)
2 SHALL NOT BE SUSPENDED. A PERSON SENTENCED TO IMPRISONMENT FOR
3 LIFE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PAROLE.

4 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
5 Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4819 (request
6 no. 04706'95) of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
