



HOUSE BILL No. 4967

June 15, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Hammerstrom and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend section 955 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, entitled as amended
"Michigan election law,"
being section 168.955 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 955 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of
2 1954, being section 168.955 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 955. ~~The petitions~~ A RECALL PETITION shall be signed
5 by A NUMBER OF registered and qualified electors equal to ~~not~~
6 ~~less than 25% of~~ AT LEAST 1 MORE THAN the number of votes cast
7 for ~~candidates for the office of governor~~ THAT ELECTIVE OFFICER
8 at the last preceding ~~general~~ election in ~~the electoral~~
9 ~~district of the~~ WHICH THAT officer ~~sought to be recalled~~ WAS
10 ELECTED TO THAT OFFICE. ~~Upon written demand, the~~ THE county

1 clerk, within 5 days OF A WRITTEN REQUEST, shall certify the
2 minimum number of signatures required for the recall of an offi-
3 cer in the governmental unit in which recall is sought.

4 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
5 Senate Joint Resolution _____ or House Joint Resolution
6 ____Q____ (request no. 01928'95 *) of the 88th Legislature becomes
7 a part of the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1
8 of article XII of the state constitution of 1963.
