



# HOUSE BILL No. 4995

September 12, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Law and Whyman and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 8121 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended  
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"  
as amended by Act No. 138 of the Public Acts of 1994, being section 600.8121 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 8121 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1961, as amended by Act No. 138 of the Public Acts of 1994,  
3 being section 600.8121 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended  
4 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 8121. (1) The sixteenth district consists of the city  
6 of Livonia, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

7 (2) The seventeenth district consists of the township of  
8 Redford in the county of Wayne, is a district of the third class,  
9 and has 2 judges.

1       (3) The eighteenth district consists of the city of  
2 Westland, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

3       (4) The nineteenth district consists of the city of  
4 Dearborn, is a district of the third class, and has 3 judges.

5       (5) The twentieth district consists of the city of Dearborn  
6 Heights, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

7       (6) The twenty-first district consists of the city of Garden  
8 City, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.

9       (7) The twenty-second district consists of the city of  
10 Inkster, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.

11       (8) The twenty-third district consists of the city of  
12 Taylor, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

13       (9) The twenty-fourth district consists of the cities of  
14 Allen Park and Melvindale, is a district of the third class, and  
15 has 2 judges.

16       (10) The twenty-fifth district consists of the city of  
17 Lincoln Park, is a district of the third class, and has 2  
18 judges.

19       (11) The twenty-sixth district consists of the cities of  
20 River Rouge and Ecorse, is a district of the third class, and is  
21 divided into the following election divisions:

22       (a) The first division consists of the city of River Rouge  
23 and has 1 judge.

24       (b) The second division consists of the city of Ecorse and  
25 has 1 judge.

1       (12) The twenty-seventh district consists of the cities of  
2 Wyandotte and Riverview, is a district of the third class, and is  
3 divided into the following election divisions:

4       (a) The first division consists of the city of Wyandotte and  
5 has 1 judge.

6       (b) The second division consists of the city of Riverview  
7 and has 1 judge.

8       (13) The twenty-eighth district consists of the city of  
9 Southgate, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.

10       (14) The twenty-ninth district consists of the city of  
11 Wayne, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.

12       (15) The thirtieth district consists of the city of Highland  
13 Park, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

14       (16) The thirty-first district consists of the city of  
15 Hamtramck, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

16       (17) The thirty-second-a district consists of the city of  
17 Harper Woods, is a district of the third class, and has 1 judge.

18       (18) The thirty-second-b district consists of the cities of  
19 Grosse Pointe Woods, Grosse Pointe Park, Grosse Pointe, and  
20 Grosse Pointe Farms, and the village of Grosse Pointe Shores, is  
21 a district of the third class, and has 1 judge. Subject to sec-  
22 tion 9940(6), this district may have 1 additional judge effective  
23 January 1, 1985, or January 1, 1987.

24       (19) The thirty-third district consists of the cities of  
25 Trenton, Gibraltar, Woodhaven, Rockwood, and Flat Rock and the  
26 townships of Brownstown and Grosse Ile in the county of Wayne, is  
27 a district of the third class, and has 2 judges. Subject to

1 section 8175, this district may have 1 additional judge effective  
2 January 1, 1995.

3       (20) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the  
4 thirty-fourth district consists of the townships of Sumpter, Van  
5 Buren, and Huron in the county of Wayne and the cities of Romulus  
6 and Belleville, is a district of the third class, and has 3  
7 judges. If the city of Romulus and the township of Huron approve  
8 the reformation of the thirty-fourth district pursuant to law and  
9 the city of Belleville and the townships of Sumpter and Van Buren  
10 approve the creation of the thirty-fourth-a district pursuant to  
11 law, the thirty-fourth district consists of the city of Romulus  
12 and the township of Huron, is a district of the third class, and  
13 has 2 judges effective January 1, 1997.

14       (21) If the city of Romulus and the township of Huron  
15 approve the reformation of the thirty-fourth district pursuant to  
16 law and the city of Belleville and the townships of Sumpter and  
17 Van Buren approve the creation of the thirty-fourth-a district  
18 pursuant to law, the thirty-fourth-a district consists of the  
19 city of Belleville and the townships of Sumpter and Van Buren, is  
20 a district of the third class, and has 1 judge effective  
21 January 1, 1997.

22       (22) The thirty-fifth district consists of the cities of  
23 Northville and Plymouth and the townships of Northville,  
24 Plymouth, and Canton in the county of Wayne, is a district of the  
25 third class, and has 2 judges. SUBJECT TO SECTION 8175, THIS  
26 DISTRICT MAY HAVE 1 ADDITIONAL JUDGE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1997.
