



HOUSE BILL No. 5016

September 12, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Bryant and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976,
entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 1165.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1165 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 1165. (1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL PROMOTE AND ENCOURAGE
6 SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO OFFER, AND PUPILS TO ENROLL IN, HIGH SCHOOL
7 COURSES IN PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, AND BIOLOGY, AND SHALL ENCOURAGE
8 COMPLETION OF THOSE COURSES IN THAT SEQUENCE.

1 (2) A SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFERING HIGH SCHOOL COURSES IN
2 PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, AND BIOLOGY SHALL NOT REQUIRE ENROLLMENT IN
3 OR COMPLETION OF ANY OF THE THOSE COURSES AS A PREREQUISITE TO
4 ENROLLMENT IN ANY OF THE OTHER COURSES. A PUPIL ENROLLED IN THE
5 HIGH SCHOOL SHALL BE ALLOWED TO ENROLL IN ANY 1 OR MORE OF THOSE
6 COURSES REGARDLESS OF THE GRADE IN WHICH THE PUPIL IS ENROLLED.
