



HOUSE BILL No. 5106

September 21, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Schroer and Hammerstrom and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 117 of chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled "Of county officers," being section 55.117 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 117 of chapter 14 of the Revised
2 Statutes of 1846, being section 55.117 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 117. (1) ~~Notaries~~ A NOTARY public shall reside in
5 the county for which ~~they are~~ HE OR SHE IS appointed ~~, but~~
6 ~~they~~ OR, IN THE CASE OF A PERSON WHO DOES NOT RESIDE IN THE
7 STATE OF MICHIGAN, A NOTARY PUBLIC SHALL HAVE HIS OR HER PRINCI-
8 PAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS
9 APPOINTED.

1 (2) A NOTARY PUBLIC may act as ~~such notaries~~ A NOTARY in
2 any part of this state. ~~; and they shall~~

3 (3) A NOTARY PUBLIC MAY receive for ~~their~~ HIS OR HER serv-
4 ices such fees as are provided by law.
