



HOUSE BILL No. 5183

October 3, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Bullard, Perricone, Jersevic and Kukuk and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled "Income tax act of 1967," as amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 502; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, as
2 amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 502 to read as follows:

4 SEC. 502. FOR THE 1996 TAX YEAR AND EACH TAX YEAR AFTER
5 1996, THE CREDIT ALLOWED BY SECTIONS 520 AND 522 SHALL BE CLAIMED
6 ONLY BY A SENIOR CITIZEN WHO HAS NO TAXABLE INCOME FOR THE TAX
7 YEAR.

 2 269, 271, 273, 274, 439, 440, 475, 483, and 527a of Act No. 281
 3 of the Public Acts of 1967, being sections 206.30b, 206.255,
 4 206.257, 206.260, 206.261, 206.262, 206.263, 206.264, 206.269,
 5 206.271, 206.273, 206.274, 206.439, 206.440, 206.475, 206.483,
 6 and 206.527a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are repealed effec-
 7 tive January 1, 1996.

8 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
