



# HOUSE BILL No. 5207

October 5, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Bush, Perricone, Brewer, Hill, Jellema, McBryde, Middaugh, Goschka, Ryan, Gernaat, Green and Byl and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931,  
entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 316a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as  
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 316a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 316A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ACT,  
5 A PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN CONDUCT PROSCRIBED UNDER CHAPTER X, CON-  
6 CERNING ARSON AND BURNING, THAT RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF AN INDI-  
7 VIDUAL IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND SHALL BE PUNISHED BY  
8 IMPRISONMENT FOR LIFE.

1           Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
2 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5206 (request  
3 no. 05278'95) of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
