

HOUSE BILL No. 5211

October 5, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Lowe and Gernaat and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Kalkaska county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to the township of Clearwater, in the county of
- 3 Kalkaska, for consideration of \$1.00, certain state owned prop-
- 4 erty located in the township of Clearwater, Kalkaska county,
- 5 Michigan, and further described as follows:
- 6 N 1/2 of the SE 1/4, Section 33, T28N, R8W, Clearwater
- 7 Township, Kalkaska, Michigan.
- 8 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide
- 9 that the property conveyed shall be used exclusively for public
- 10 purposes and that upon termination of that use, or upon use for

- 1 any other purpose, title to the property shall revert immediately
- 2 to the state, with the state assuming no liability for improve-
- 3 ments made at the grantee's expense.
- 4 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 5 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve
- 6 to the state all rights to coal, oil, gas, and other minerals,
- 7 excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic minerals found
- 8 on or under the property conveyed.
- 9 Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 10 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
