



HOUSE BILL No. 5395

November 9, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Law, Bryant and Bankes and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend chapter VIII of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended
"The code of criminal procedure,"
as amended, being sections 768.1 to 768.36 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Chapter VIII of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts
2 of 1927, as amended, being sections 768.1 to 768.36 of the
3 Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 2a to read
4 as follows:

5 CHAPTER VIII

6 SEC. 2A. A JUDGE OF THE RECORDER'S COURT OF THE CITY OF
7 DETROIT WHO IS A VISITING JUDGE IN THE THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
8 SHALL INFORM THE DEFENDANT IN EACH CRIMINAL CASE IN WHICH HE OR
9 SHE IS A VISITING JUDGE, ON THE RECORD, THAT THE DEFENDANT HAS

1 THE RIGHT TO HAVE HIS OR HER CASE HEARD BY A JUDGE APPOINTED OR
2 ELECTED TO THE THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT WHO IS NOT A VISITING JUDGE
3 FROM THE RECORDER'S COURT OF THE CITY OF DETROIT.
