

HOUSE BILL No. 5448

November 30, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Pitoniak, DeMars, Brewer, Varga, Scott, Bobier and Hanley and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 105 of the Public Acts of 1939, entitled

"An act relative to the filing of claims of dower with the register of deeds; and to declare the effect of this act,"

being section 558.91 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 105 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1939, being section 558.91 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. (1) All persons A PERSON having or claiming
- 5 dower, whether inchoate or consummate, in lands -heretofore or
- 6 hereafter conveyed IN THE PAST OR IN THE FUTURE, or otherwise
- 7 disposed of, by the person who is or was the -husband SPOUSE of
- 8 the person claiming such dower, shall, within 25 years from the
- 9 time of -such- THE conveyance or other disposal of -said- THE

- I lands, or within 6 months after this act shall take effect BY
- 2 MARCH 29, 1940, file in the office of the register of deeds of
- 3 the county in which such THE lands are situated, a claim of
- 4 dower under oath setting forth the name and address of the
- 5 persons PERSON claiming such dower and the name of the person
- 6 who is or was HIS OR her -husband SPOUSE and through whom HE OR
- 7 she claims to have obtained dower in -such THE lands and a
- 8 description of the lands in which dower is claimed. -: Provided,
- 9 however, That this
- 10 (2) THIS act shall apply APPLIES only to persons A
- 11 PERSON having or claiming dower, inchoate or consummate, in lands
- 12 conveyed or otherwise disposed of subsequent to a time 25 years
- 13 prior to AFTER August 10, 1917, that being the time Act No. 58
- 14 of the Public Acts of 1917 became effective 1892.
