



HOUSE BILL No. 5500

January 11, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Bush and Llewellyn and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956,
entitled as amended

"The insurance code of 1956,"

as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 107.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
2 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 107 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 107. AS USED IN THIS ACT, "LIMITED BENEFIT INSURANCE"
6 MEANS ACCIDENT AND SICKNESS INSURANCE DESIGNED, ADVERTISED, AND
7 MARKETING TO SUPPLEMENT MAJOR MEDICAL INSURANCE INCLUDING ACCIDENT
8 ONLY, CHAMPUS SUPPLEMENT, DENTAL, DISABILITY INCOME, FIXED
9 INDEMNITY, LONG-TERM CARE, MEDICARE SUPPLEMENT, SPECIFIED

1 DISEASE, VISION, AND ANY OTHER ACCIDENT AND SICKNESS INSURANCE
2 OTHER THAN BASIC HOSPITAL EXPENSE, BASIC MEDICAL-SURGICAL
3 EXPENSE, OR OTHER MAJOR MEDICAL INSURANCE.
