



HOUSE BILL No. 5737

A bill to amend section 354 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled as amended "The management and budget act," as amended by Act No. 286 of the Public Acts of 1995, being section 18.1354 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 354 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of
2 1984, as amended by Act No. 286 of the Public Acts of 1995, being
3 section 18.1354 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 354. (1) The executive budget for each fiscal year
6 shall contain an estimate of the transfer into or out of the fund
7 required by section 352.

8 (2) The legislature shall include a final estimate of the
9 transfer into or out of the fund required by section 352 in the

1 appropriations bill ~~which~~ THAT contains the revenue estimate
2 required by section 31 of article IV of the state constitution of
3 1963.

4 (3) Except as provided in subsection (7), a transfer into
5 the fund shall be made in equal monthly installments throughout
6 the fiscal year. Except as provided in subsection (7), a trans-
7 fer out of the fund may be made as needed during the fiscal
8 year.

9 (4) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995 only, all
10 general fund-general purpose balances at the final close of the
11 fiscal year are appropriated in the following order:

12 (a) Up to \$22,653,100.00 are appropriated for distribution
13 to the state's 15 universities and 28 community colleges. Of the
14 \$22,653,100.00 available for distribution to the state's 15 uni-
15 versities and 28 community colleges, \$18,805,186.00 shall be dis-
16 tributed to universities and \$3,847,914.00 shall be distributed
17 to community colleges in the manner provided in subsections (5)
18 and (6). If the general fund-general purpose balances at the
19 final close of the fiscal year are less than \$22,653,100.00, the
20 distribution to the state's 15 universities and 28 community col-
21 leges shall be reduced proportionally.

22 (b) If the general fund-general purpose balances at the
23 final close of the fiscal year exceed \$22,653,100.00, the addi-
24 tional general fund-general purpose balances up to \$5,000,000.00
25 are ~~hereby~~ appropriated for state special maintenance
26 projects.

1 (c) If the general fund-general purpose balances at the
 2 close of the fiscal year exceed \$27,653,100, all remaining
 3 balances are ~~hereby~~ appropriated into the counter cyclical
 4 budget and economic stabilization fund. This appropriation shall
 5 be used to satisfy requirements under section 26 of article IX of
 6 the state constitution of 1963.

7 (5) The appropriation for the state's 15 universities appro-
 8 priated in subsection (4) shall be allocated to the universities
 9 as follows:

25 (6) The appropriation for the state's 28 community colleges
 26 appropriated in subsection (4) shall be distributed to the

1 colleges in direct proportion to the 1995 fiscal year
 2 unrestricted operating appropriations as follows:

6 (7) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996 only,
7 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (8), all general fund-general
8 purpose balances at the final close of the fiscal year are hereby
9 appropriated and shall be transferred to the fund.

10 Notwithstanding section 352, the total amount transferred to the
11 fund under this subsection shall be considered to be the amount
12 transferred to the fund for purposes of section 352 for the
13 fiscal year ending September 30, 1996 only.

14 (8) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996 only,
15 there is appropriated THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS IN THE FOLLOWING
16 ORDER OF PRIORITY:

17 (A) \$20,000,000.00 TO THE MICHIGAN VETERANS TRUST FUND TO BE
18 UTILIZED FOR THE VETERANS EDUCATION TUITION PROGRAM.

19 (B) \$391,300.00 to the city of Detroit to fund the Detroit
20 crime lab and the Detroit police special events unit.
