



HOUSE BILL No. 5924

June 4, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Jaye and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976,
entitled as amended

"The revised school code,"

as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 1304.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1304 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 1304. THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL ADOPT AND
6 MAINTAIN A POLICY THAT REQUIRES A PUPIL TO MAINTAIN A GRADE POINT
7 AVERAGE OF AT LEAST 2.0 ON A 4.0 SCALE, OR THE EQUIVALENT ON
8 ANOTHER SCALE, TO BE ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IN A DRIVER EDUCATION
9 COURSE CONDUCTED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT UNDER

1 SECTION 811 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, ACT NO. 300 OF THE
2 PUBLIC ACTS OF 1949, BEING SECTION 257.811 OF THE MICHIGAN
3 COMPILED LAWS. A BOARD MAY GRANT EXCEPTIONS FROM THIS POLICY FOR
4 PUPILS WHO ARE MARRIED OR FOR WHOM THE BOARD DETERMINES THAT
5 THERE ARE EXTENUATING FAMILY FINANCIAL PRESSURES THAT WOULD
6 RESULT IN UNDUE HARDSHIP IF THE PUPIL WERE NOT ALLOWED TO ENROLL
7 IN THE DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE.
