

HOUSE BILL No. 6039

September 11, 1996, Introduced by Rep. Profit and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend Act No. 197 of the Public Acts of 1975, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the establishment of a downtown development authority; to prescribe its powers and duties; to correct and prevent deterioration in business districts; to encourage historic preservation; to authorize the acquisition and disposal of interests in real and personal property; to authorize the creation and implementation of development plans in the districts; to promote the economic growth of the districts; to create a board; to prescribe its powers and duties; to authorize the levy and collection of taxes; to authorize the issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness; to authorize the use of tax increment financing; to reimburse downtown development authorities for certain losses of tax increment revenues; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state officials,"

as amended, being sections 125.1651 to 125.1681 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 28a.

- 1 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 28a to read as
- 2 follows:
- 3 SEC. 28A. (1) BEGINNING APRIL 1, 1997 AND EVERY YEAR AFTER
- 4 APRIL 1, 1997, AN AUTHORITY DESCRIBED IN THIS ACT SHALL CAUSE TO
- 5 BE PUBLISHED IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE
- 6 MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH THE AUTHORITY IS LOCATED A STATEMENT OF
- 7 ASSETS AND LIABILITIES AND AN INCOME AND EXPENSE STATEMENT OF
- 8 THAT AUTHORITY FOR THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.
- 9 (2) IF THE AUTHORITY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (1),
- 10 THE AUTHORITY SHALL RETURN ALL TAX INCREMENT REVENUE RECEIVED
- II DURING THE PERIOD THAT THE AUTHORITY FAILED TO COMPLY WITH SUB-
- 12 SECTION (1) TO THE APPROPRIATE TAXING JURISDICTION FROM WHICH THE
- 13 TAX INCREMENT REVENUE CAME.
