

SENATE BILL No. 357

March 1, 1995, Introduced by Senator GEAKE and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 415 of the Public Acts of 1982, entitled

"Correctional officers' training act of 1982,"
being section 791.502 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 415 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1982, being section 791.502 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Central training academy" means the central training
- 6 academy established pursuant to section 15.
 - (b) "Correctional facility" means either of the following:
- 8 (i) A facility or institution which THAT houses an inmate
- 9 population under the jurisdiction of the department of
- 10 corrections.

- 1 (ii) A municipal or county jail, work camp, lockup, holding
- 2 center, halfway house, community corrections center, or any other
- 3 facility maintained by a municipality or county, OR MAINTAINED BY
- 4 A PRIVATE ENTITY UNDER CONTRACT WITH A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY
- 5 PURSUANT TO THE ALTERNATIVE JAILS ACT, which houses adult
- 6 prisoners.
- 7 (c) "Council" means the correctional officers' training
- 8 council created under section 3.
- 9 (d) "Department" means the state department of
- 10 corrections.
- (e) "Executive secretary" means the executive secretary of
- 12 the council.
- 13 (f) "Local correctional officer" means any EITHER OF THE
- 14 FOLLOWING:
- (i) A person employed by a unit of local government in a
- 16 correctional facility as a correctional officer, or that person's
- 17 immediate supervisor.
- 18 (ii) A PERSON EMPLOYED IN A PRIVATELY OPERATED JAIL ESTAB-
- 19 LISHED PURSUANT TO THE ALTERNATIVE JAILS ACT AS A CORRECTIONAL
- 20 OFFICER, OR THAT PERSON'S IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR.
- 21 (g) "State correctional officer" means any A person
- 22 employed by the department in a correctional facility as a cor-
- 23 rectional officer or a corrections medical aide, or that person's
- 24 immediate supervisor.
- 25 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 26 Senate Bill No. 356
- 27 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
