

## SENATE BILL No. 706

September 27, 1995, Introduced by Senators STILLE, POSTHUMUS, SCHUETTE, BENNETT, ROGERS, GOUGEON, STEIL, GAST, GEAKE, DE GROW, NORTH, KOIVISTO and SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend the title and section 14 of Act No. 287 of the Public Acts of 1964, entitled

"An act to provide for the organization and functions of the state boards of education under the constitutions of 1908 and 1963; to provide for the appointment and functions of the superintendent of public instruction under the constitution of 1963; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

being section 388.1014 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. The title and section 14 of Act No. 287 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1964, being section 388.1014 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 TITLE
- 5 An act to provide for the organization and functions of the
- 6 state boards of education under the constitutions of 1908 and
- 7 1963; to provide for the appointment and CERTAIN functions of

- 1 the superintendent of public instruction under the constitution
- 2 of 1963; and to repeal -certain- acts and parts of acts.
- 3 Sec. 14. After June 30, 1965, a reference in any law to
- 4 the powers and duties of the superintendent of public instruction
- 5 is deemed to be made to the state board unless the law names the
- 6 superintendent as a member of another governmental agency or pro-
- 7 vides for an appeal to the state board of education from a deci-
- 8 sion of the superintendent, in which cases the reference is
- 9 deemed to be made to the superintendent of public instruction
- 10 appointed under the 1963 constitution. Such superintendent of
- 11 public instruction shall be responsible for the execution of the
- 12 policies of the state board. The state board may delegate any of
- 13 its functions to him. He THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC
- 14 INSTRUCTION. THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION shall be
- 15 the principal executive and administrative officer of the state
- 16 department of education.
- 17 Section 2. Sections 12 and 13 of Act No. 287 of the Public
- 18 Acts of 1964, being sections 388.1012 and 388.1013 of the
- 19 Michigan Compiled Laws, are repealed.
- 20 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unles:
- 21 Senate Joint Resolution R
- of the 88th Legislature becomes a part of
- 23 the state constitution of 1963 as provided in section 1 of arti-
- 24 cle XII of the state constitution of 1963.
