

## **SENATE BILL No. 1123**

September 10, 1996, Introduced by Senator CARL and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 11 of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended

"The general law village act,"

being section 61.11 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 11 of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1895, being section 61.11 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. II. Every elector residing in such territory and
- 5 qualified to vote for township officers in the township in which
- 6 such territory or some part thereof may be situate, OF SUCH
- 7 TERRITORY IS LOCATED may vote at all elections in -said THE
- 8 INCORPORATED village, and all the laws of this state in relation
- 9 to the election of township officers, canvass of votes,
- 10 certifying the election of officers, and notifying -them-

- I OFFICERS of their election, shall apply to -such THE first
- 2 election of officers in -such THAT village -, so far as the same
- 3 may be IF applicable and not inconsistent with the provisions of
- 4 this act. FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTERING TO VOTE AND VOTING AT AN
- 5 ELECTION, SPECIAL ELECTION, OR PRIMARY ELECTION ON A REAL PROP-
- 6 ERTY TAX ISSUE OR A VILLAGE PROPOSAL OR VILLAGE QUESTION ONLY, A
- 7 PERSON IS CONSIDERED TO RESIDE IN THE VILLAGE TO BE AFFECTED BY
- 8 THE RESULT OF THAT ELECTION IF THAT PERSON OWNS, AND HAS PAID ALL
- 9 ASSESSED AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES ON, REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN
- 10 THAT VILLAGE.
