



# SENATE BILL No. 1123

September 10, 1996, Introduced by Senator CARL and referred  
to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 11 of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts  
of 1895, entitled as amended  
"The general law village act,"  
being section 61.11 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 11 of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of  
2 1895, being section 61.11 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 11. Every elector residing in such territory ~~—~~ and  
5 qualified to vote for township officers in the township in which  
6 such territory or ~~some~~ part ~~thereof may be situate,~~ OF SUCH  
7 TERRITORY IS LOCATED may vote at all elections in ~~said~~ THE  
8 INCORPORATED village, and all the laws of this state in relation  
9 to the election of township officers, canvass of votes,  
10 certifying the election of officers, and notifying ~~them~~

1 OFFICERS of their election, shall apply to ~~such~~ THE first  
2 election of officers in ~~such~~ THAT village ~~, so far as the same~~  
3 ~~may be~~ IF applicable and not inconsistent with the provisions of  
4 this act. FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTERING TO VOTE AND VOTING AT AN  
5 ELECTION, SPECIAL ELECTION, OR PRIMARY ELECTION ON A REAL PROP-  
6 ERTY TAX ISSUE OR A VILLAGE PROPOSAL OR VILLAGE QUESTION ONLY, A  
7 PERSON IS CONSIDERED TO RESIDE IN THE VILLAGE TO BE AFFECTED BY  
8 THE RESULT OF THAT ELECTION IF THAT PERSON OWNS, AND HAS PAID ALL  
9 ASSESSED AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES ON, REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN  
10 THAT VILLAGE.
