A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4626 AS INTRODUCED 4-15-97

Currently, under the Michigan Liquor Control Act, a brewpub may have an interest in up to two other brewpubs in the state, but the production of beer is capped at 5,000 barrels per calendar year for all brands and labels produced state-wide. The bill would amend the act to increase the total allowable state-wide production of a brewpub to 12,000 barrels per year, with a cap of 4,000 barrels per each location.
