A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5359 (SUBSTITUTE H-1) AS INTRODUCED 11-6-97

Under Part 435 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (NREPA), which regulates hunting and fishing licenses, a resident of the state who is 65 years of age or older may obtain small game, firearm deer, archery deer, bear hunting, wild turkey hunting and fur harvester's licenses at a 60 percent discount from established fees. A senior citizen also receives a 50 percent discount on a daily fishing license, and a 60 percent discount on restricted and all-species fishing licenses. House Bill 5359 would amend the act to allow a senior citizen to purchase a second hunting license, or either type of fishing license, for a spouse for \$1.00.
