

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 758**

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding sections 1606b, 1606c, 1606d,
and 1606e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1606B. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING A
2 COMMUNITY COLLEGE UNDER THIS PART MAY ESTABLISH A DEPARTMENT OF
3 PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR THE PROTECTION OF
4 PERSONS AND PROPERTY.

5 (2) IF THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT ESTABLISHES A
6 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE BOARD MAY
7 GRANT TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS THE AUTHORITY OF PEACE OR LAW
8 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

1 (3) BEFORE GRANTING THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY PROVIDED UNDER
2 SUBSECTION (2), THE BOARD SHALL CONDUCT NOT LESS THAN 2 PUBLIC
3 HEARINGS.

4 (4) THE BOARD SHALL NOT GRANT THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY
5 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) UNLESS THAT BOARD CREATES A PUBLIC
6 SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE. THE PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE
7 SHALL BE COMPRISED OF 2 MEMBERS OF THE FACULTY AND 2 MEMBERS OF
8 THE STAFF OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE. THE PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY
9 COMMITTEE SHALL RECEIVE AND ADDRESS GRIEVANCES BY PERSONS AGAINST
10 THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR AGAINST THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPART-
11 MENT OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE. THE COMMITTEE MAY RECOMMEND TO
12 THE BOARD OR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE THAT
13 DISCIPLINARY MEASURES BE TAKEN AGAINST A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OR
14 POLICE OFFICER WHO IS FOUND RESPONSIBLE FOR MISCONDUCT IN
15 OFFICE.

16 SEC. 1606C. (1) THE JURISDICTION OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS
17 OR POLICE OFFICERS GRANTED POWERS AND AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION
18 1606B SHALL INCLUDE ALL PROPERTY OWNED OR LEASED BY THE COMMUNITY
19 COLLEGE IN THIS STATE AND EXTENDS TO THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY
20 TRAVERSING OR CONTIGUOUS TO THAT PROPERTY.

21 (2) THE JURISDICTION OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE
22 OFFICERS UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS LIMITED TO THE PROTECTION OF
23 PERSONS AND PROPERTY ON THE PROPERTY OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE
24 UNLESS A RESPONSE IS MADE OFF CAMPUS AT THE SPECIFIC REQUEST OF
25 ANOTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR UNDER A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT
26 WITH ANOTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

1 SEC. 1606D. PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE OFFICERS OF A
2 COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO WHOM THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF A PEACE OR
3 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER ARE GRANTED UNDER SECTION 1606B SHALL
4 MEET THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF THE MICHIGAN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFI-
5 CERS TRAINING COUNCIL ACT OF 1965, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 TO
6 28.616.

7 SEC. 1606E. THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT OF EACH COMMUNITY
8 COLLEGE SHALL SUBMIT MONTHLY UNIFORM CRIME REPORTS PERTAINING TO
9 CRIMES WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT'S JURISDICTION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 STATE POLICE IN THE SAME MANNER AS UNIFORM CRIME REPORTS ARE SUB-
11 MITTED UNDER SECTION 1 OF 1968 PA 319, MCL 28.251.

12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
13 effect unless all of the following bills of the 89th Legislature
14 are enacted into law:
